

STUDIETRUST BURSARIES

This page provides information on Studietrust's access (partial) bursaries. **A prospective student only has to submit one single application form. Each application will automatically be considered for all the bursaries for which a particular applicant qualifies.** This means that an application for an FNB Fund bursary, for instance, will also be considered for a Studietrust access bursary and vice versa.

◆ Applications are invited for the following types of access bursaries:

- ◆ School bursaries (Grades 9-12)
- ◆ Agricultural College bursaries
- ◆ FET College bursaries
- ◆ University of Technology bursaries
- ◆ University bursaries

◆ SCHOOL BURSARIES (Grades 9-12)

Who can apply? All South African learners from **Grades 9 – 12**.

Preference is given to learners from rural areas with **Mathematics and Physical Science** as subjects who maintain an average of at least **70%** in all their subjects.

Bursary amount: Studietrust awards partial bursaries based on academic merit and financial need.

Annual closing date: 31 August for requesting or downloading application forms and 30 September for submitting hard copy and online applications._

◆ BURSARIES FOR STUDYING AT AGRICULTURAL COLLEGES

Who can apply? SA citizens interested in full-time diploma studies at any recognised South African Agricultural College. Applicants should have Matric or an NSC with diploma endorsement with Mathematics.

Preference is given to:

- applicants from **rural areas**
- applicants who already completed an NSC or already matriculated but who are **not**

yet registered at a college

- current Grade 12 learners **intending to register** at a college.

Bursary amount: Studietrust awards partial bursaries based on academic merit and financial need.

Annual closing date: 31 August for requesting or downloading application forms and 30 September for submitting hard copy and online applications.

◆ BURSARIES FOR STUDYING AT FURTHER EDUCATION & TRAINING (FET) COLLEGES

Preferred study programmes:**• Business and General Study Programmes:**

Secretarial/Administrative; Financial/Business/Marketing Management; Educare; Tourism; Catering/Food/Hospitality Services; Human Resource Management, etc.

• Engineering Programmes:

All Engineering programmes including Mechanical/Electrical Engineering; Boilermaking; Millwrights, Plumbing; Diesel Mechanics; Building and Construction, etc.

Who can apply? SA citizens interested in full-time studies towards an NSC (Vocational) and beyond.

Preference is given to:

- applicants from **rural areas**
- applicants who already completed an NSC or already matriculated but who are **not yet registered** at a college
- current Grade 12 learners **intending to register** at a college.

Bursary amount: Studietrust awards partial bursaries based on academic merit and financial need.

Annual closing date: 31 August for requesting or downloading application forms and 30 September for submitting hard copy and online applications.

◇ BURSARIES FOR STUDYING AT UNIVERSITIES OF TECHNOLOGY

Who can apply? SA citizens interested in full-time studies at any South African University of Technology.

Preference is given to:

- applicants from **rural areas**
- applicants who already completed an NSC or already matriculated who are **not yet registered** at a university of technology
- current Grade 12 learners **intending to register** at a university of technology who maintain an average of at least **50%** in all their subjects.

Preferred study areas:

- Agriculture, Horticulture, Nature Conservation
- Building and Construction
- Chemistry (Science)
- Commerce (Accounting, Banking, Cost & Management Accounting, Financial Management, Internal Auditing, etc.)
- Consumer Studies and Retailing
- Education
- Engineering – all programmes
- Environmental Health
- Information Technology
- Logistics
- Marketing
- Office Management and Technology
- Public Management / Relations
- Town & Regional Planning
- Travel, Tourism, Hospitality, Food Services

Annual closing date: 31 August for requesting or downloading application forms and 30 September for submitting hard copy and online applications.

◇ BURSARIES FOR STUDYING AT UNIVERSITIES

Who can apply? Studietrust awards access bursaries to prospective or current degree students at South African universities.

Selection criteria:

Studietrust may award bursaries to students in any field of study, but students studying towards degrees in the following fields will get preference:

- Agriculture
- Commerce
- Education
- Engineering

Preference is further given to:

- applicants from rural areas
- applicants with matric/NSC Maths and Science
- applicants with at least 60% or 4 on the NSC scale of achievement in English second language HG or English First Additional Language.
- applicants with an NSC or matric waiting for a study opportunity
- current Grade 12 learners intending to study at a university
- who maintain an average of at least **50%** in all their subjects.

Bursary amount: Studietrust awards partial bursaries based on academic merit and financial need.

Annual closing date: 31 August for requesting or downloading application forms and 30 September for submitting hard copy and online applications.
